Open Water Scuba Course

The Scuba One, PADI (Professional Association of Diving Instructors) beginning Open Water Certification Course consists of three sections. Classroom (eLearning), Knowledge Review/Pool and Open Water. The Knowledge Review and Pool sessions are usually offered on a weekend or in the evening. We meet at Scuba One for class and use the Mandan Aquatic Center for pool training. Skills are performance-based so if a student needs more time in the pool at a later date there is no extra charge. Students can register for the eLearning Open Water Diver class by clicking the link on our website, eLearning needs to be complete before the knowledge review/pool training days.

The classroom portion is online. The online course is designed so once it is downloaded, you can use a computer, tablet or smartphone and progress through the course at your own pace.

To become a PADI Open Water Diver, the student needs to complete four open water dives. These dives take a minimum of two days. We offer the dives in ND, MN and/or provide a signed referral written in your logbook (included in course price) which can be present to another instructor while you are on vacation.

When taking the course online, the class/pool fee includes the electronic dive planner ERDP App, and a PADI Diver's Log with training record, for you to keep. **You do NOT need to purchase the optional book packet PADI offers when signing up online, as we include it with the pool training.** While we provide all equipment for the course, we highly recommend the purchase of at least a mask, fins, and snorkel due to the personal nature of this equipment. Our equipment pricing will always be competitive, and we will make sure to offer what works best for you.
